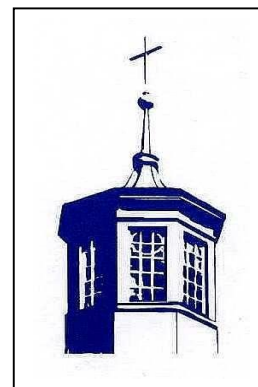

<b>Sunday, July 30</b>	Football, soccer & volleyball camp registration <b>Football, soccer, and volleyball</b> practice officially starts July 31, 2017 this fall. MSHSAA, our governing body for athletics passed a heat acclimatization schedule for 16 days that all schools have to follow to start the fall practices. The guidelines are on <a href="http://mshsaa.org">mshsaa.org</a> under sports medicine tab, then under Heat/Hydration & Conditioning Recommendations. <b>Soccer and volleyball</b> local students will be allowed to stay at home the entire 2-week camp. Dorm students will need to live in the dorm for the two weeks of camp unless they have a host family. Cost for soccer and volleyball dorm students for two weeks will be \$200. This figure includes all meals. *Dorm students with filled out parent permission and host permission forms may stay with a local student. Meals WILL NOT be included if staying with a host family. 2:00-4:00 pm	Check in for football, soccer, and volleyball camps. Student Government will assist students moving into the dormitories.
2:00-4:00 pm	All offices will be open for you to conduct business. Please submit all school forms at the Student Personnel Office (SPO) and complete all financial arrangements. Evening meal is on your own.
<b>Monday, July 31</b>	Football, soccer & volleyball camps begin
<b>July 31-August 4</b>	All offices will be open 8:00 am to 3:00 pm
<b>Sunday, August 6</b>	Sunday, August 6 the <b>football team</b> (local and dorm students) will move into the annex for the remainder of camp. The cost of camp on campus will be \$100 per player. This figure includes all meals. If a football player stays in the dorm the first week, the total charge is \$200.
<b>Monday, August 7</b>	<b>Cheerleading and the ladies golf team</b> will start camp on August 7. Local students will be allowed to stay at home and dorm students will need to be in the dorm for \$100 per athlete. This figure includes all meals. **Dorm students with filled out parent permission and host permission forms may stay with a local student.

2:15-3:00 pm	New students (day and dorm) enjoy a campus tour with Student Government. Parents of new (day and dorm) students stay in Kaepfel for assimilation activities and our mission.
