**Dr. Jerrode Baker Marsh**, a native of the northwest, received her Master and Doctorate Degrees in Piano Performance from the UT Austin. In 1998 she moved in Frankfurt, Germany, where she worked for 17 years as a professional musician, performing as a solo pianist, conductor, and collaborative artist throughout Europe, as well as working as a church music director at an international English-speaking Lutheran Church. She moved to Concordia, Missouri, in June 2015 and began work as the music director at Saint Paul Lutheran High School. While living in Germany, she coached and performed with a number of professional singers, most of whom sing in international opera houses throughout the world. As a conductor and collaborative pianists, she worked with many of the orchestra

members of the *Hessische Rundfunk Orchester*, (Hessen Radio Symphony), as well as many free-lance artists. She was the founder and artistic director/conductor of the *Trinity International Concert Choir, e.V.* an 80-voiced concert choir that performed major choral works with professional orchestras to high critical acclaim. She also worked as an auxiliary pianist with *Oper Frankfurt* (Frankfurt Opera), coaching and conducting singers and accompanying some of their additional projects.

As a church music director, she also developed a very active music program, composing and arranging music and organizing musical events and presentations. Her children, youth, and adult choirs were regularly requested to perform for many prestigious community events and international services.

Dr. Marsh directs the *Singing Saints* (Concert Choir), the *Saint Paul Chamber Choir*, the *Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra*, and the *Concert Band*. She also supervises the private voice and strings program at the school, where nearly all of her students placed in the Division 1 Category (highest possible) at the Missouri State Solo Festival in 2017. The Singing Saints will be making their first European concert tour in May 2018, where they will perform in Germany, Slovakia, Hungary, Poland and the Czech Republic. In addition to her ensembles, she teaches upper-division Conversational German and the dual credit college level Music Appreciation course at Saint Paul Lutheran High School.
