Community

Saint Paul Lutheran High School is located in Concordia, Missouri. Concordia has a population of around 2,450 people and is located right off Interstate 70 and about 50 miles east of Kansas City, Missouri. The student body is culturally diverse with students from 17 different counties and 15 different states.

School

Saint Paul Lutheran High School is a private, residential, four-year high school with 215 students in grade 9-12. The school opened in 1883 and was once a residential high school and junior college. In 1986 the junior college closed, and Saint Paul remained a residential high school. Saint Paul is accredited by the National Lutheran School Accreditation and AdvancEd.

Curriculum

The **academic program** is organized around a daily, eight-hour class schedule. Students attend up to eight 45-minute classes per day, five days per week.

Advanced Placement® courses are offered in Calculus, Computer Science, and Computer Science Principles.

College level classes are offered that allow students to obtain college credit while in high school. Saint Paul has teachers who are certified to teach these college classes through Concordia University, Nebraska. College classes include Physics, Chemistry, Speech, Composition, Introduction to Literature, Music, Old Testament, New Testament, and American Civilization.

Honors classes are offered in Algebra I and Chemistry.

Grading, Ranking, and Grade Point Average (GPA)

Letter Grade	Percentage Grade	Points for GPA
A – Excellent	92-100	4

Ranking is determined by student’s **Grade Point Average (GPA)**. Students receive the appropriate number of points for their grades in classes and that number is divided by the total number of classes taken. College level classes are on a weighted scale (5 points for an A, 4 points for a B, etc.). The student with the highest GPA will receive a #1 ranking, the second highest GPA will receive a #2 ranking, etc.

- 7 earned 2.50 – 2.99
- 5 earned 2.0 – 2.49
