

WHITETAILED UNLIMITED - DAVIS CREEK CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

The local Chapter of Whitetails Unlimited Davis Creek established this scholarship fund in 2012 for a full-time or part-time senior in Lafayette County who will further their education at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, technical, or trade school. This scholarship is governed by the following criteria:

Selection Criteria

- The recipients must be a student in **Lafayette County**.
- The recipient must have been **accepted** into an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university, technical, or trade school.
- The recipient must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Financial need will be considered but may not serve as the determining factor.
- Selection will be based upon the application. The committee reserves the right to automatically award the scholarship to immediate relatives of members in the Whitetails Unlimited Chapter.
- The recipient will be selected without regard to sex, race, creed, or college major.

The Recipient (s) will be selected and will be contacted personally by the scholarship committee. Should the intended recipients be unable to accept any portion of the scholarship within the following year, an alternate candidate may receive any or all monies remaining. If the recipient does not attend an institute of higher education during the intended semester, the money is subject to revocation and redistribution.

Payment shall be made in the form of one check, payable jointly to the recipient and the college. Proof of enrollment must be presented in order to receive payment. Amount of the scholarship may vary.

The selection committee is comprised of active members of the Whitetails Unlimited Davis Creek Chapter. The high school counselor may assist the committee in an advisory capacity.

Deadline for applications will be April 14. Presentation of the scholarship will occur annually at the recipient's high school Scholarship Awards Program.
