The Saint Paul SOS met on April 24th, 2019 with 11 in attendance. SOS Minutes from the March meeting were reviewed and approved as presented. Pastor Mehl shared a devotion and prayer to begin the meeting.

REPORTS

Executive Director Report: The speaker for graduation is the Bishop of Slovakia. We are switching over the student information system. We are looking at what projects can be done on Saints Pride Day which is June 13th-15th.

Treasurer's report: The spring rummage sale brought in \$9000.00. We currently have a balance of \$24,355.30 with a few bills outstanding for commitments to the school that have not yet been received.

Student Government report: Jenna Frerking was present and did not have anything to report at this time.

PROJECT REVIEW:

Saints Store: The treasurer's report showed a profit of \$2,279.02.

Non prom had 15 students and was a simple meal this year. Next year we would like to look at additional activities.

UPCOMING SPECIAL PROJECTS:

The Awards Banquet is coming up on May 16th and SOS pays for the awards and other miscellaneous items associated with the banquet within the set budget.

Rummage Sale: There are many volunteers who have been helping with collecting and pricing items for the next rummage sale. Rita is asking for a small refrigerator for drinks for volunteers. Leslie Spells is offering to run an ebay account to sell a Christmas village collectables and other valuables that could be sell for closer to actual value. Rita is asking for approval for an Ebay account to be started for rummage sale items. The next rummage sale date in the fall has not been set yet. The first Monday of each month is drop off and 3rd Mondays are a work day. We will need someone to do publicity as we get closer to the next sale.

There was a discussion about possibly renaming the group for next year to more clearly communicate who we are and what we do. This will be revisited at the next meeting.

SOS will consider ways we can be a volunteer presence when parents are on campus for athlete arrival (August 11th) and new student orientation (August 17th).

The next SOS meeting will be in July with the exact date to be determined.
