Eligibility Guidelines

1. All graduating high school seniors, residing in the Concordia R-II School District, or attending Saint Paul Lutheran High School and residing in the local area (Advisory Board Approval), wishing to continue his/her education at a 2-year or 4-year post-secondary or a technical institute.

General Information

1. The Tri-Co Community Foundation, Concordia, Missouri, will administrate the Scholarship.
2. This scholarship is not based upon grade point average.
3. This scholarship has been created to serve as an educational stipend to refund the awarded student(s) the cost of items that are associated with or necessary for, completion of individual courses or training sessions at a community college or university
4. Scholarship recipients will be presented at the July Annual Meeting of the Concordia Area Chamber of Commerce.

Requirements

1. The completed application form and photo.
2. Applicant will be requested to meet, in person or virtually, with the Advisory Board following the application deadline, so that the Board may conduct an oral interview.
