## READY TO MAKE A COMMITMENT TO THE FOR ALL THE SAINTS CAMPAIGN?

## WHO IS MANAGING THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE?

The second phase will begin as soon as the first phase is funded and completed. The goal for the beginning of this phase is winter of 2021.
