The Saint Paul SOS met on November 14th, 2018 with 14 in attendance. The Student Government Representatives were present. The Executive Director was attending a Board of Trustee meeting. SOS Minutes from the October meeting were reviewed and approved as presented.

REPORTS:

Angie Beerman is exiting the Saints Store committee. Leslie Spells and Abbie Wasson have begun working with Rhonda at this point. They have sold 28 chairs as new items. Wrapping and shipping will be available for Christmas and the card machine has made a big difference in sales.

UPCOMING SPECIAL PROJECTS:

Jen Isdell will organize the Christmas Choir Concert reception on December 9th.

The Sausage Dinner will tentatively be on March 24th which is the same day as the Spring Choir Concert. We will firm up the date at our January 9th SOS meeting.

Court warming is February 1st and we will sponsor a Chili and Soup Dinner that day.

Prom is on April 13th and we will discuss "Non-Prom" at a later meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

We still need volunteers to facilitate the transition process for taking over the annual rummage sale. The ladies who run the rummage sale wrote a letter giving their “two-sale notice”. They will organize their last sale this Spring and then will not do it anymore. They are asking for a transition team to teach people how it is organized. SOS understands that upcoming sales may not be as big as the last few years and is appreciative of anyone willing to give of their time to facilitate this important fundraiser.

Some investigation has been done into purchasing vending machines so that the school can benefit from what is sold and it was agreed that the upfront costs and revenue is not worth pursuing at this time. This item has been tabled.

NEW BUSINESS:

Kent Kunkel talked about the capital campaign. A video is being produced and will be ready soon. He is already meeting with people and there will be an official kick off on February 9th. The weekend before the kickoff (court warming) there will be a student and community prayer walk.

Marta Pitch reports she needs people to sign up for gatekeepers.

Tom Long contacted SOS asking for funding to purchase uniforms for our growing wrestling team. Last year we had two people on the team and this year we have four new people signed up. The total amount would be approximately \$160.00-\$200.00. This motion was passed.
